3. Director, International Surfboard Builders Hall of Fame and Chairman of the National Surf Schools and Instructors Association.



The Missions of the NSSIA and the Surf Museum



Founded in 2005, the National Surf Schools and Instructors Association (NSSIA) is an IRS non-profit organization dedicated to fostering surf etiquette, water safety, and quality surfing instruction programs through professional instructor development, education, accreditation and research. It's instructor certification and school accreditation requirements have now become the standard for professional surf instructors and coaches.

Interest in Surfing and Stand Up Paddling has grown significantly in the past several years. Working with the NSSIA, the Bruce "Snake" Gabrielson Surfing Museum and Surf Art Gallery was created by its founder as a way to extend the culture of surfing beyond the beach learning environment and present visitors with an opportunity to fully understand surfing's rich heritage.

Surfing

Traditionally surf museum exhibits include surfboards from the earliest days to more modern designs. We have gone far beyond just boards to include a full set of surf albums from the 1960s and 1970s, board making templates, a decal collection, both modern and early 60s, pictures and posters from ancient to more modern events, sculptures and ornaments, and a few trophies thrown in just for fun.. Our most famous exhibit is the Dale Velzy shaping equipment collection.
